

MAG Regional Videoconferencing System Request for Proposals (RFP)

Questions Received from December 27, 1999 to December 30, 1999

Q: In rooms that indicate two whiteboards (Chandler Room 201) on the Visio drawings, should the bidders propose two electronic whiteboards?

A: Bidders should be responsive to the RFP. Bidders should bid the specified equipment for end-sites and any equipment they believe is necessary for a successful Regional Videoconferencing System. Bidders should completely fill out Appendix D.

Q: In the interest of saving money, are the bidders expected to re-use any existing equipment? For example the hub site conference room has table microphones and a projection screen. In order to accurately bid the proposal, the bidders will need a list of equipment at each site to be re-used.

A: Bidders should be responsive to the RFP. The specifications detail the minimum equipment needs for each site. Bidders should bid whatever equipment they believe is necessary for a successful Regional Videoconferencing System.
