

MAG Regional Videoconferencing System Request for Proposals (RFP)

January 20, 2000 Update

Q: Will MAG accept an RFP response from Norstan for a Regional Videoconferencing System?

A: The Maricopa Association of Governments has concluded that it will not consider a proposal from Norstan Communications, Inc. for the Regional Videoconferencing System Request for Proposals (RFP) dated December 10, 1999. This conclusion is based on the fact that Norstan's previous consulting work for MAG on this subject presents a conflict of interest.

In addition, all proposers must include in their Proposal a statement as follows:

I certify on behalf of _____ (proposing company) that no person who was involved in any way in the videoconferencing consulting work performed for MAG by Norstan Communications Inc. participated in the preparation of this Proposal. This participation includes preparing, or relevant communications with persons preparing, this Proposal for the December 10, 1999 Regional Videoconferencing System Request for Proposals.
