

- **All recipients of Section 5310, 5316 and 5317**


- **More than one out of ten people in Maricopa County***




Population Growth

470,000 people




- 2000 population







Regional Planning Initiatives in Maricopa County


- **MAG developed 2007 plan**

 - Cited as national best practice






2008 Update to Plan

- Need and Demographic Tracking



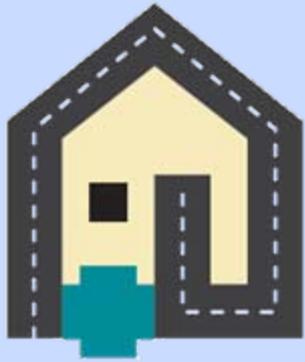


