7. Grease Interceptors

Grease traps or interceptors are passive devices required by municipalities to stop grease, fat, oil, wax or debris from entering the city's sanitary sewer system. Members will be asked to discuss best practices, what works and what does not work with grease interceptors, sizing and limitations.

8. MAG 2007 Five Percent Plan for PM-10 for the Maricopa County Nonattainment Area

Within the Maricopa County nonattainment area, the National Ambient Air Quality Standard has not yet been attained for PM-10 particulate pollution. MAG is the agency designated to develop plans to address air pollution problems. A list of 53 committed measures was included in the MAG 2007 Five Percent Plan for PM-10 to reduce particulate pollution. Some of these measures include: pave or stabilize dirt roads, sweep with street sweepers, public education and outreach programs, etc. Gaye Knight from City of Phoenix will provide an update on the Phoenix approach for implementing PM-10 measures, including the measures mandated in SB 1552 passed by the Arizona State Legislature in 2007. Invited staff from Maricopa County Air Quality Department will also provide information on this issue.
