TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT FUNDS NOW AVAILABLE

Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) Transportation Enhancement Funds will be available statewide for the design and implementation of pedestrian, bicycle, landscaping, historic preservation, archaeological, billboard removal and other projects that are related to the surface transportation system.

ADOT manages transportation enhancements in Arizona. The Maricopa Association of Governments (MAG) works with ADOT to rank applications and incorporate public input into the process.

HOW MUCH IS AVAILABLE?

Approximately \$13.0 million will be available for use throughout the entire state of Arizona this funding cycle.

WHAT TYPES OF PROJECTS ARE ELIGIBLE?

To be eligible for funding, projects need to fit into the categories established by federal law, and all projects need to relate to surface transportation. Some examples of eligible projects are:

- New or reconstructed sidewalks.
- Bike lane striping, wide paved shoulders or bike parking.
- Off-street trails or shared-use paths.
- Preservation of buildings and facades in historic districts.
- Restoration and re-use of historic buildings for transportation-related purposes.

WHEN ARE APPLICATIONS DUE?

Completed applications for projects in the Maricopa region are due to MAG by Noon on **Tuesday, April 14, 2009**. **No late applications will be accepted.**
