

 - Conducting research and special projects
 - Facilitating application processes
 - Developing regional plans






General Human Services Committees

■ Human Services Coordinating Committee (HSCC)

- Advises the MAG Regional Council on human services related issues and produces human services plans.
- Develops recommendations for the use of locally planned dollars of the Social Services Block Grant.







General Human Services

■ Human Services Technical Committee (HSTC)

- Provides technical assistance to the Human Services Coordinating Committee
- Identifies and prioritizes regional human services needs and resources.





Homelessness

■ MAG Continuum of Care Regional Committee on Homelessness

- Develops and implements the Regional Plan to End Homelessness
- Prepares a consolidated application to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development
- Implements projects critical to the application such as the Annual Homeless Street Count.



Domestic Violence



■ MAG Regional Domestic Violence Council


- Develops and implements strategies to reduce the incidence of and trauma associated with domestic violence
- Areas of focus include:
 - Training for first responders and healthcare professionals
 - Teen dating violence
 - Research





Human Services Transportation

- **Elderly and Persons with Disabilities Transportation Program Committee**
 - Determines a priority listing of Section 5310 applications for the Arizona Department of Transportation.
 - Awards include vehicles, radio equipment, software and mobility management funds.
 - Funding compliant with the MAG Human Services Coordination Transportation Plan.




