1. Will there be a pre-proposal meeting?

3. Do you know who will be on the evaluation team yet?
 - To protect the integrity of the process, we do not provide the names of individual panelists in advance. It is a geographically balanced, multi-jurisdictional panel made up of representatives from MAG member agencies.
 - The names of panelists become public record after the consultant is selected--although the finalists will, of course, meet them during the oral interview process next week. We will go around the room and introduce who is present when the interview begins.
4. Is the "labor cost allocation budget" an appendix item or part of the 10 pages?
 - The labor cost allocation budget sheet is an appendix and not part of the 10 pages.
5. Is this project a follow-up to a previous "complete streets effort" by MAG?
